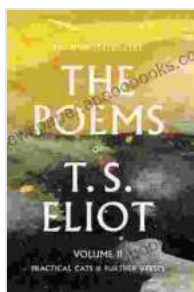

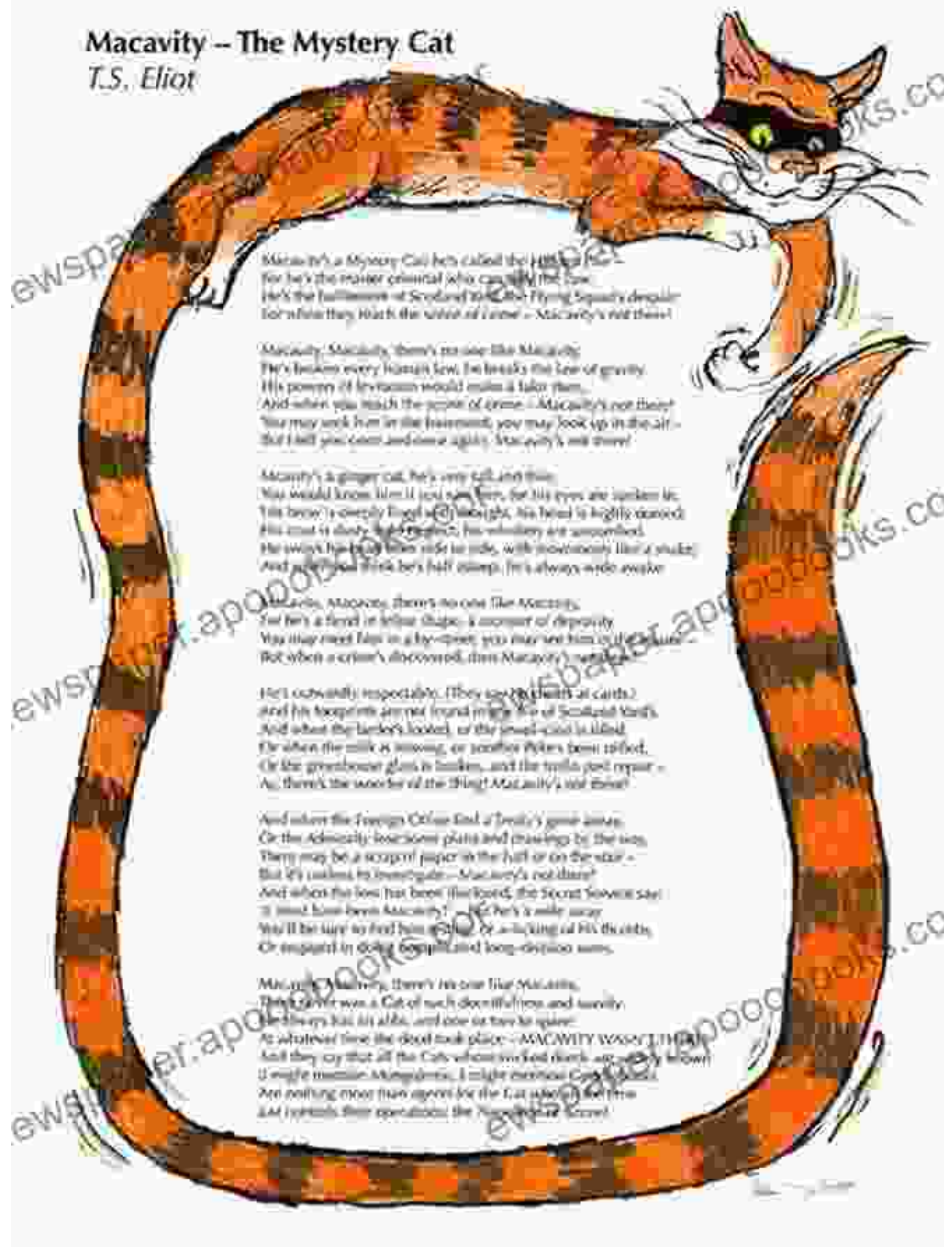

And I repeat these operations the Macavity Secret!

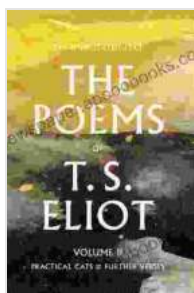

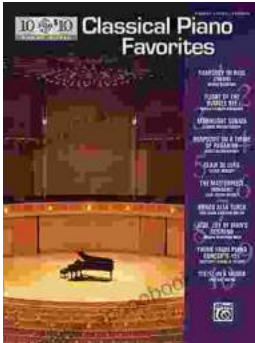

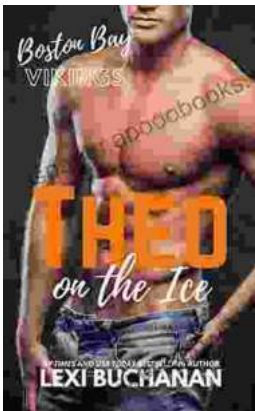
